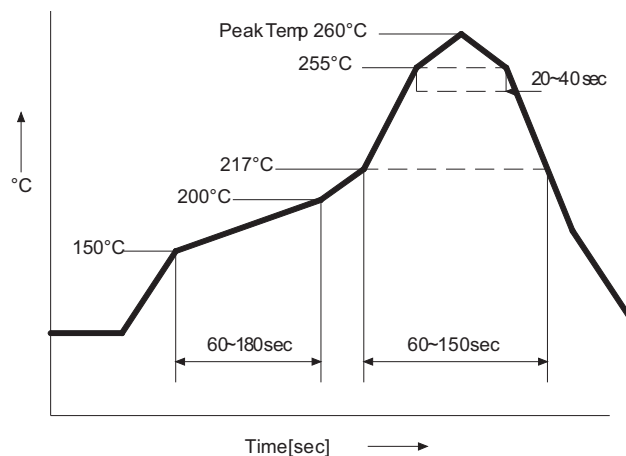

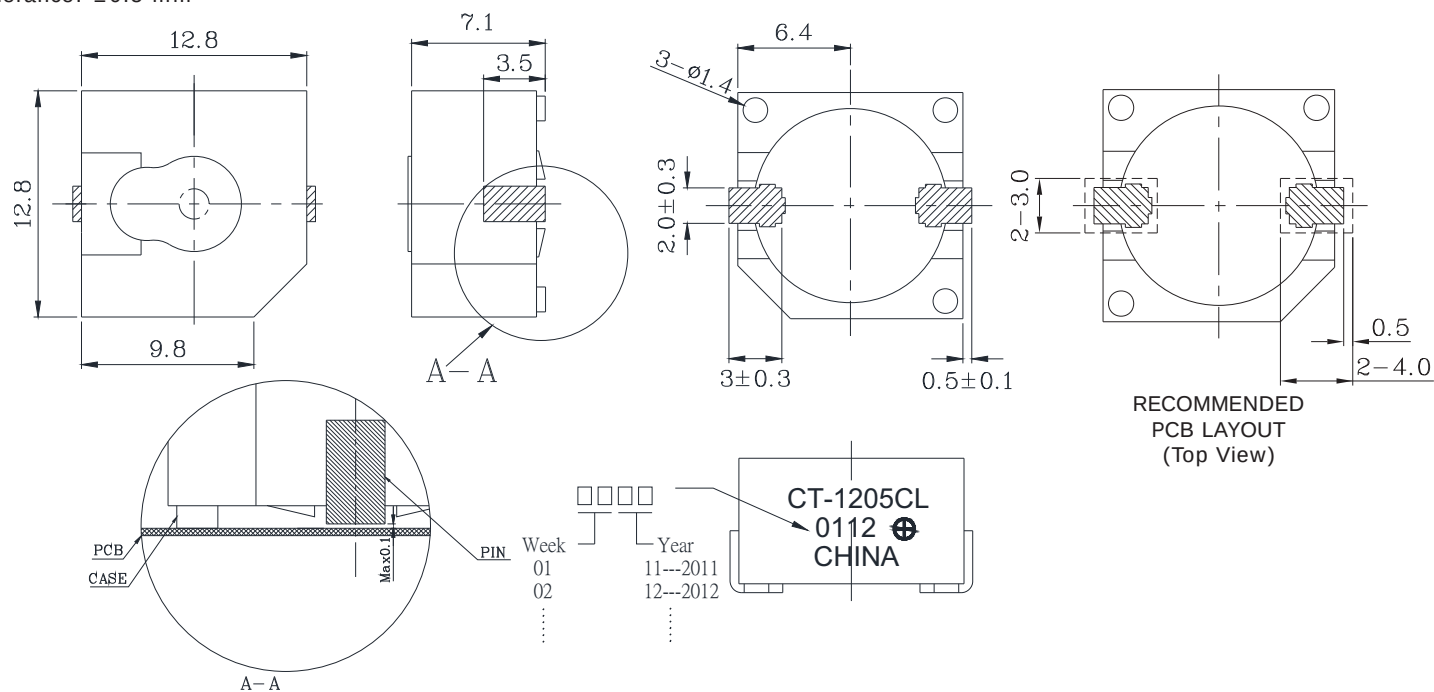

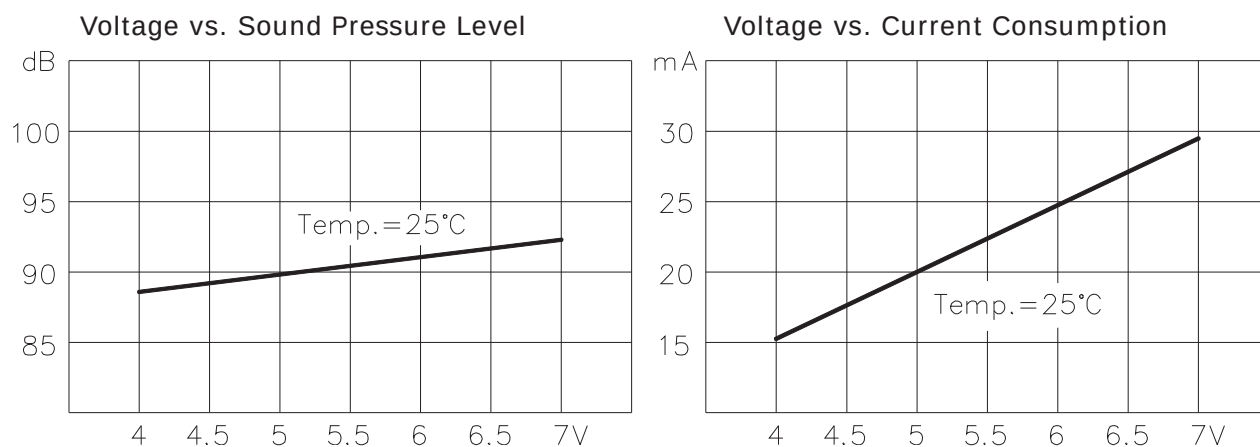


MECHANICAL DRAWING

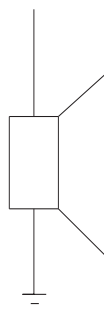
