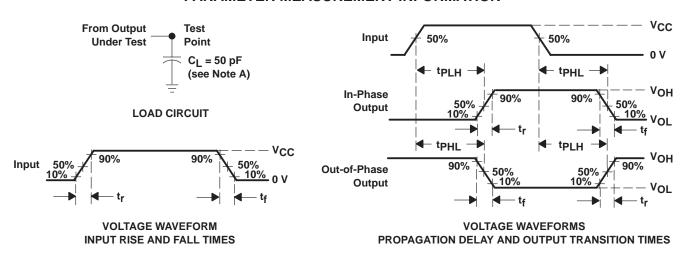

QUADRANT ASSIGNMENTS FOR PIN 1 ORIENTATION IN TAPE



- C. Publication IPC-7351 is recommended for alternate designs.
