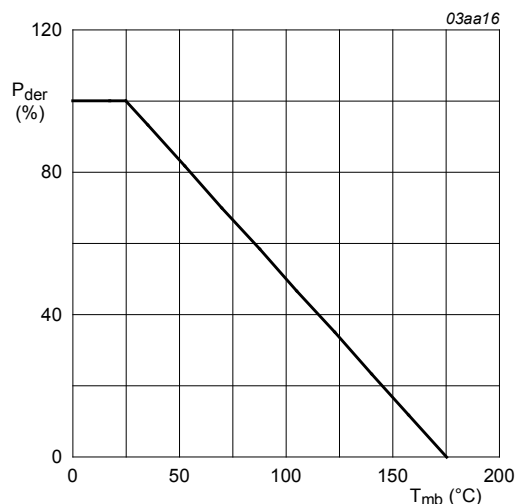

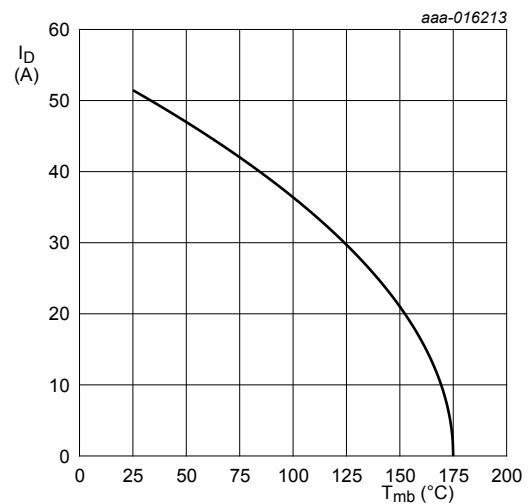

**Fig. 2. Continuous drain current as a function of mounting base temperature**

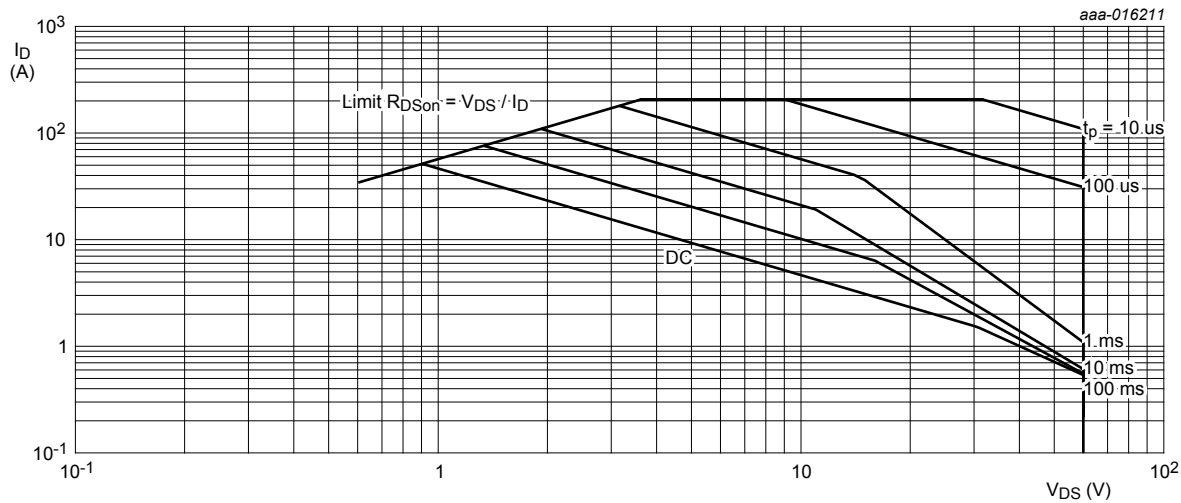


Fig. 3. Safe operating area; continuous and peak drain currents as a function of drain-source voltage

$T_{mb} = 25^{\circ}C$ ;  $I_{DM}$  is a single pulse

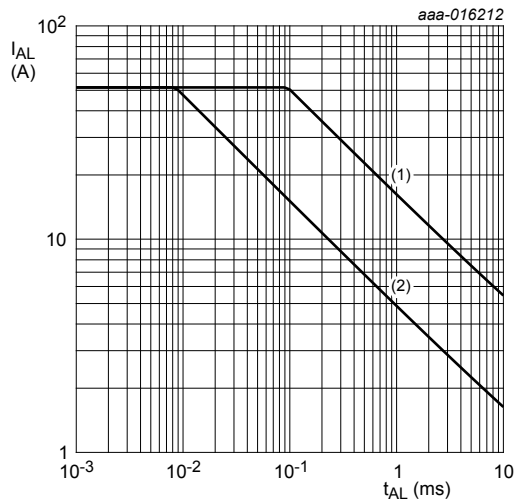


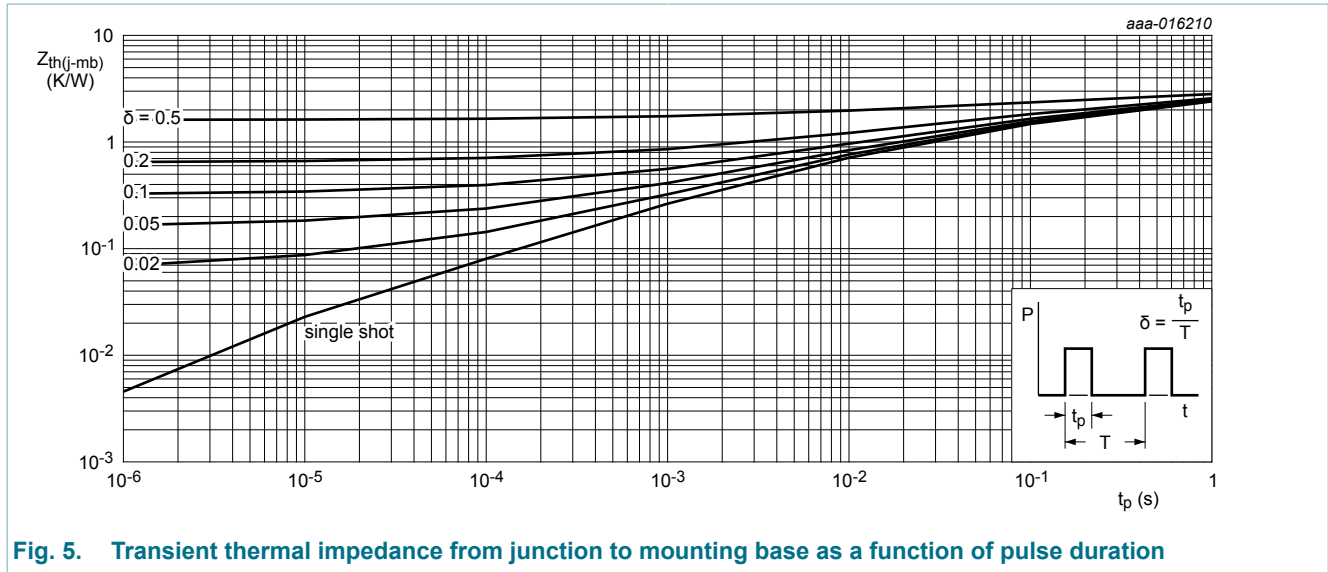
Fig. 4. Avalanche rating; avalanche current as a function of avalanche time

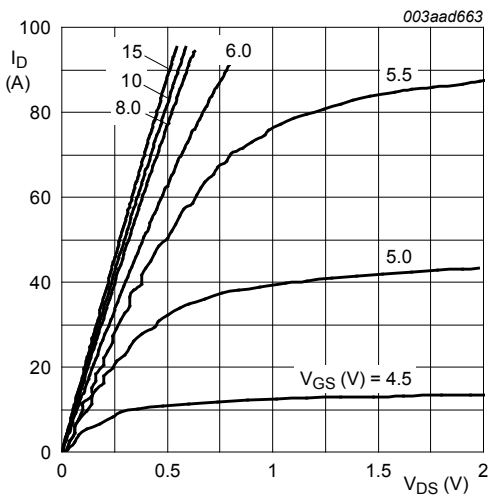


Fig. 6. Output characteristics: drain current as a function of drain-source voltage; typical values

$T_j = 25\text{ }^{\circ}\text{C}; t_p = 300\text{ }\mu\text{s}$

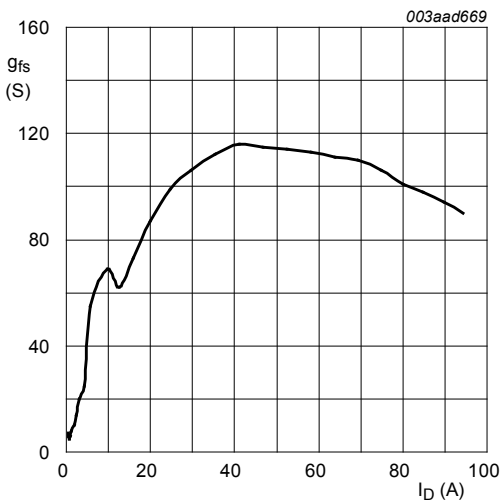


Fig. 7. Forward transconductance as a function of drain current; typical values

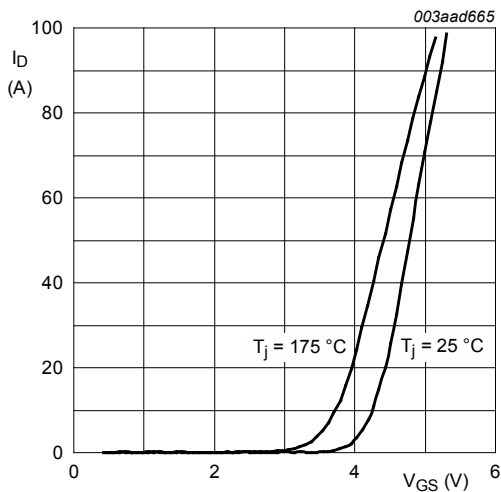


Fig. 8. Transfer characteristics: drain current as a function of gate-source voltage; typical values

$V_{DS} = 25\text{ V}$

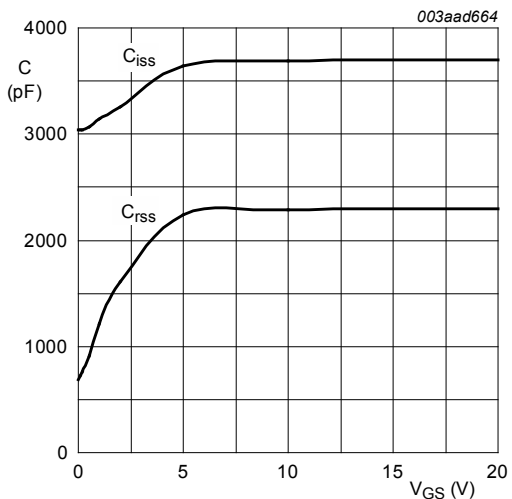


Fig. 9. Input and reverse transfer capacitances as a function of gate-source voltage; typical values

$V_{DS} = 0\text{ V}; f = 1\text{ MHz}$



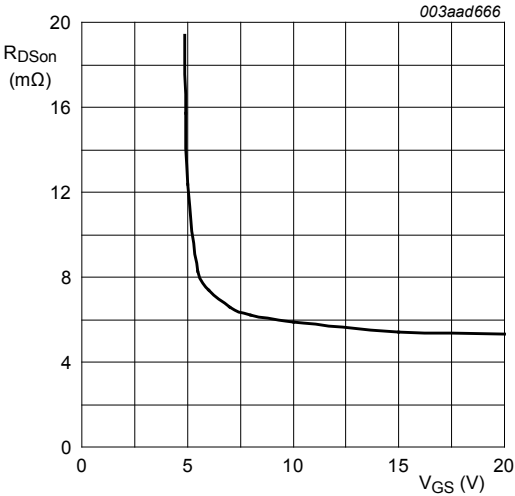


Fig. 10. Drain-source on-state resistance as a function of gate-source voltage; typical values

$$T_j = 25^{\circ}\text{C}$$

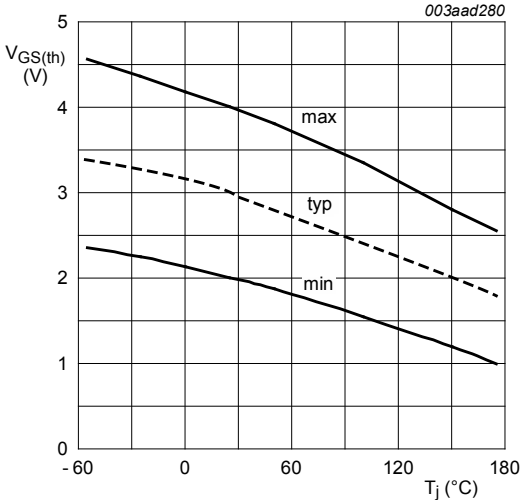


Fig. 11. Gate-source threshold voltage as a function of junction temperature

$$I_D = 1\text{ mA}; V_{DS} = V_{GS}$$

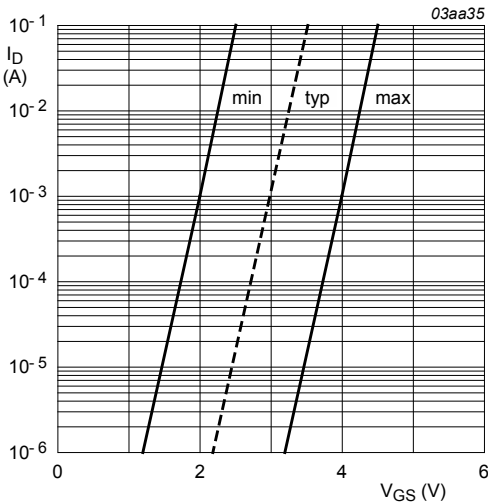


Fig. 12. Sub-threshold drain current as a function of gate-source voltage

$$T_j = 25^{\circ}\text{C}; V_{DS} = 5\text{ V}$$

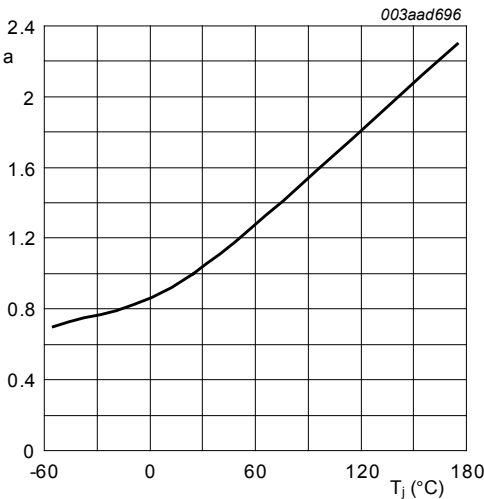


Fig. 13. Normalized drain-source on-state resistance factor as a function of junction temperature.

$$a = \frac{R_{DS(on)}}{R_{DS(on)(25^{\circ}\text{C})}}$$

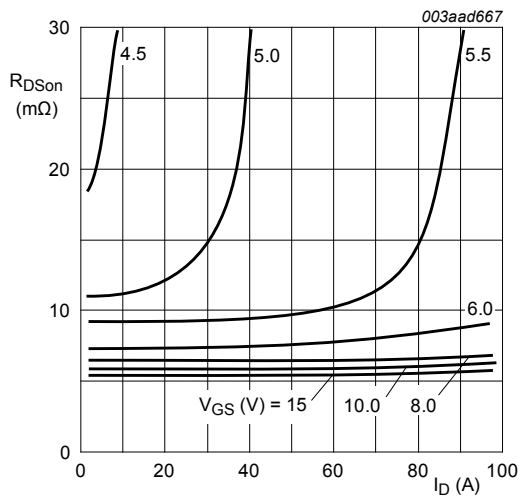


Fig. 14. Drain-source on-state resistance as a function of drain current; typical values

$T_j = 25^\circ\text{C}; t_p = 300\mu\text{s}$

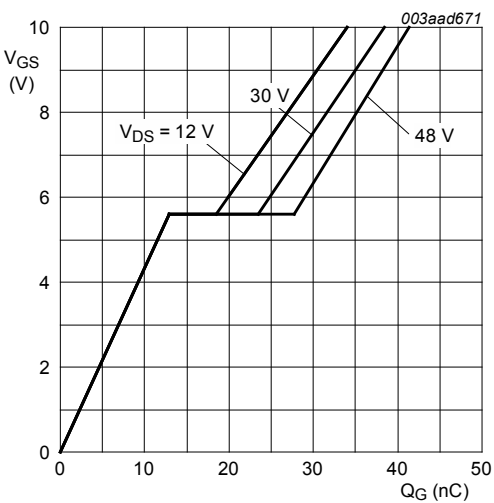


Fig. 15. Gate-source voltage as a function of gate charge; typical values

$T_j = 25^\circ\text{C}; I_D = 25\text{ A}$

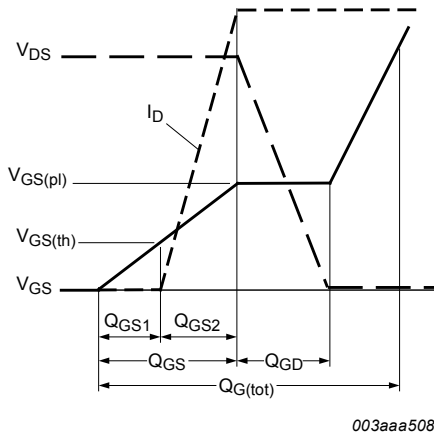


Fig. 16. Gate charge waveform definitions

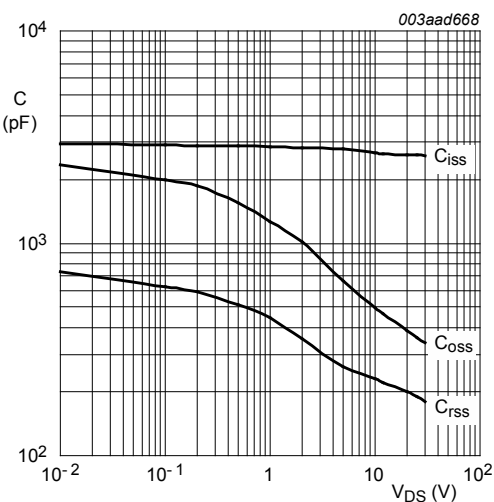


Fig. 17. Input, output and reverse transfer capacitances as a function of drain-source voltage; typical values

$V_{DS} = 0\text{ V}; f = 1\text{ MHz}$

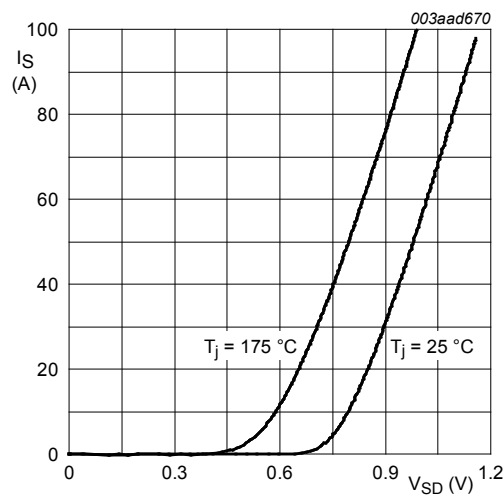


Fig. 18. Source (diode forward) current as a function of source-drain (diode forward) voltage; typical values

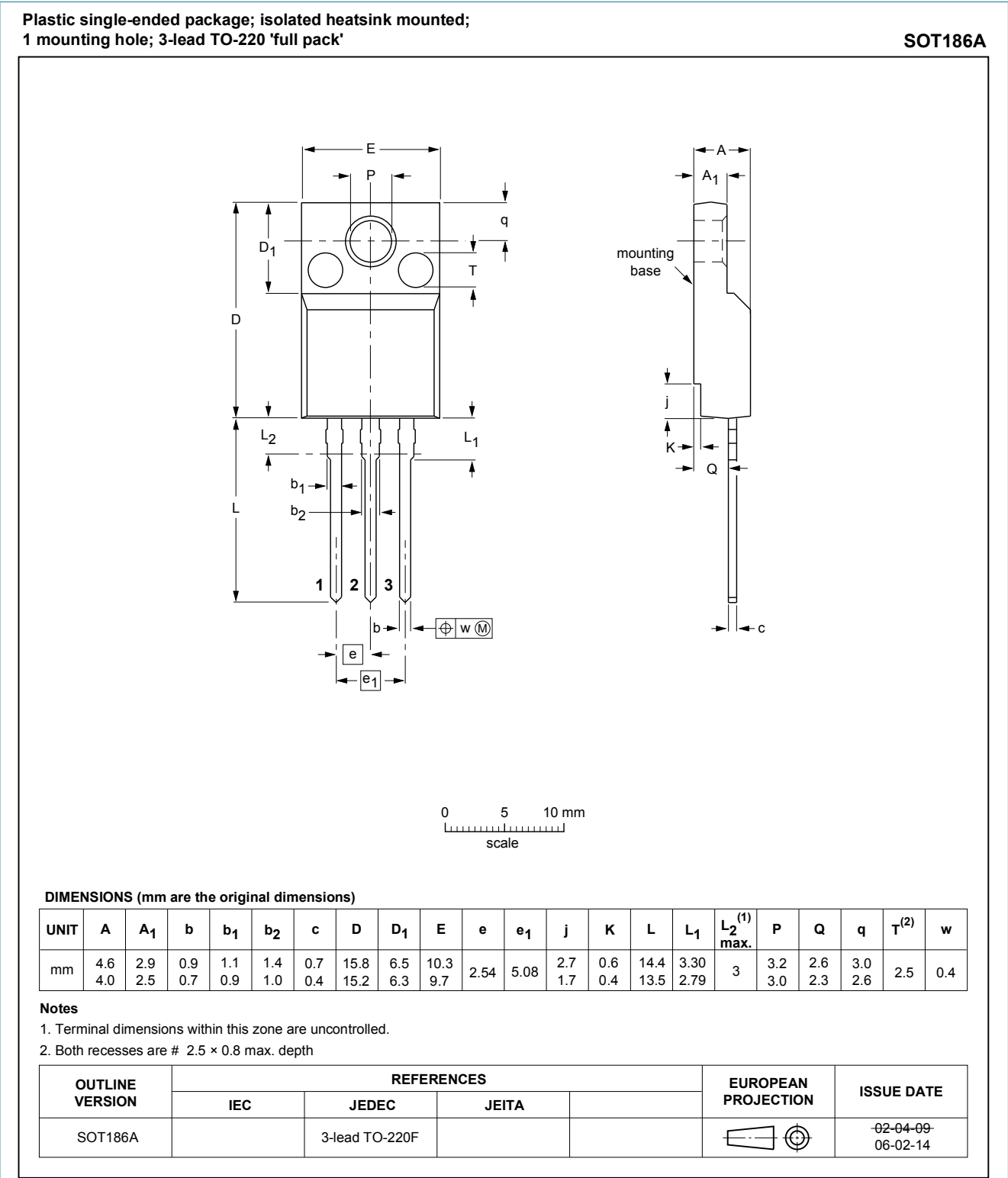


Fig. 19. Package outline TO-220F (SOT186A)
