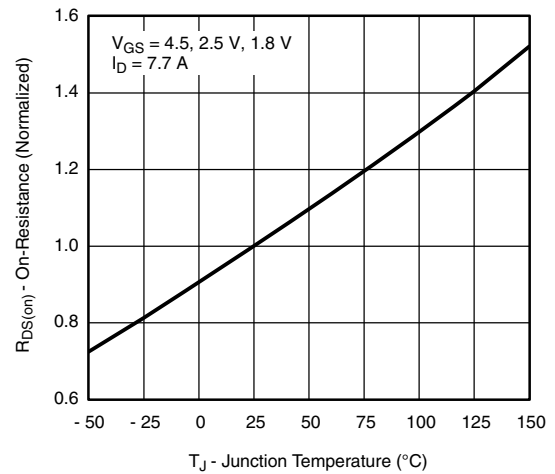
On-Resistance vs. Drain Current and Gate Voltage



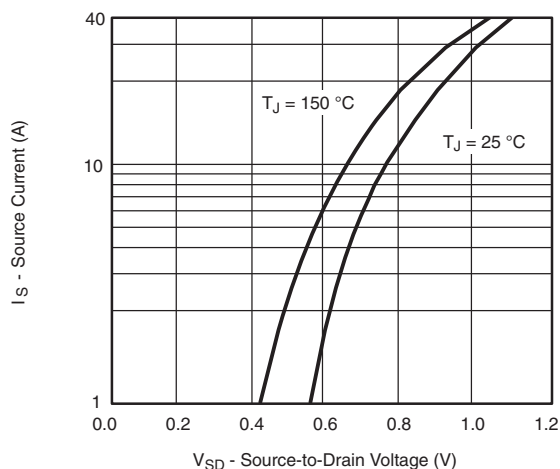
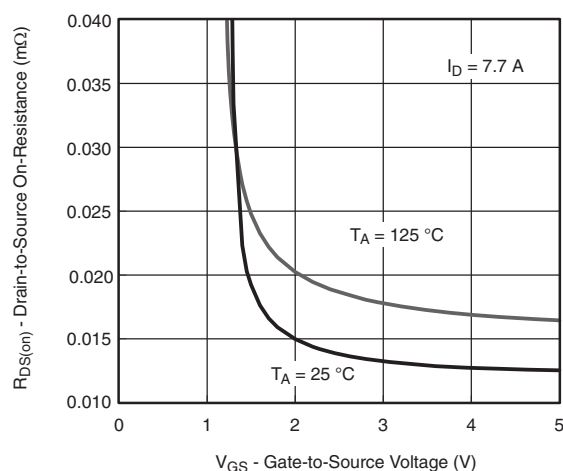
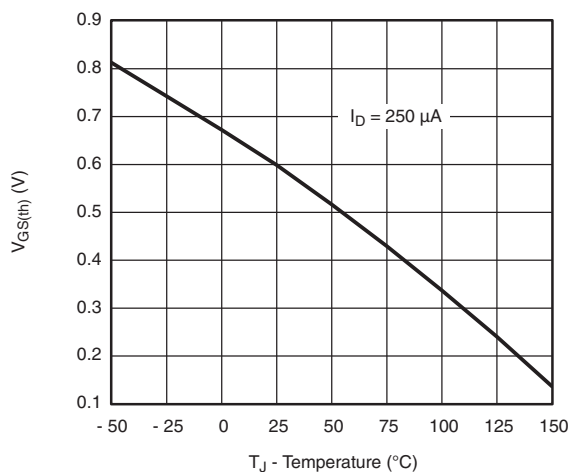
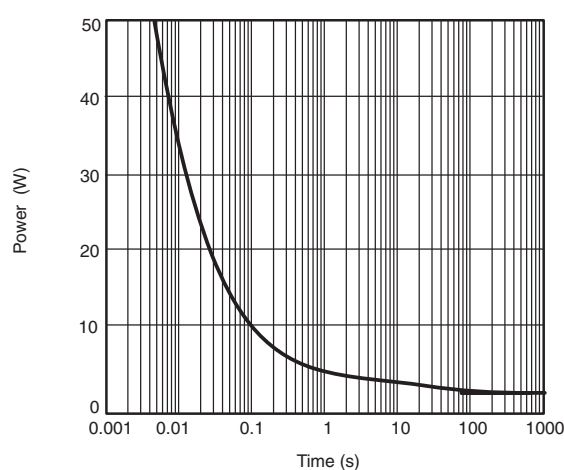
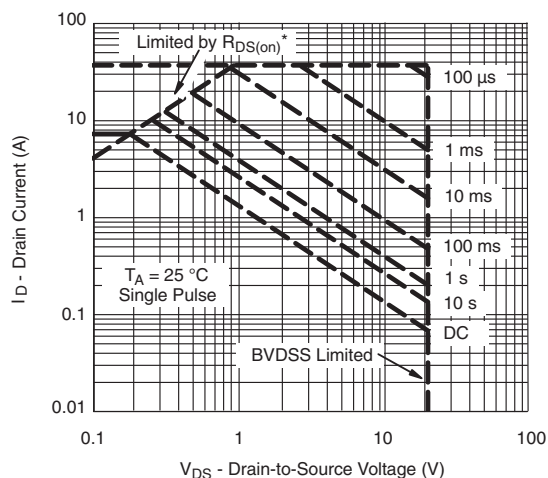

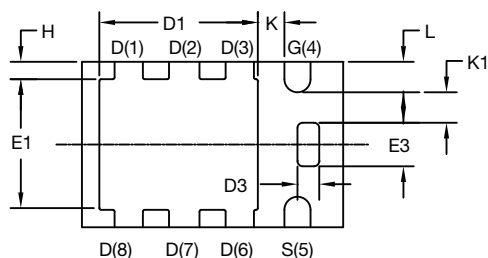
Side view of single



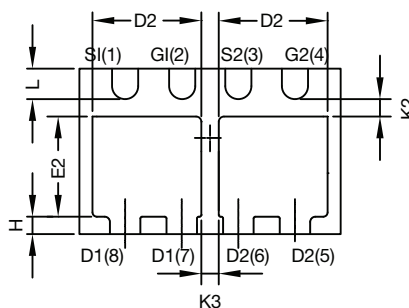
Side view of dual

Backside view of single pad



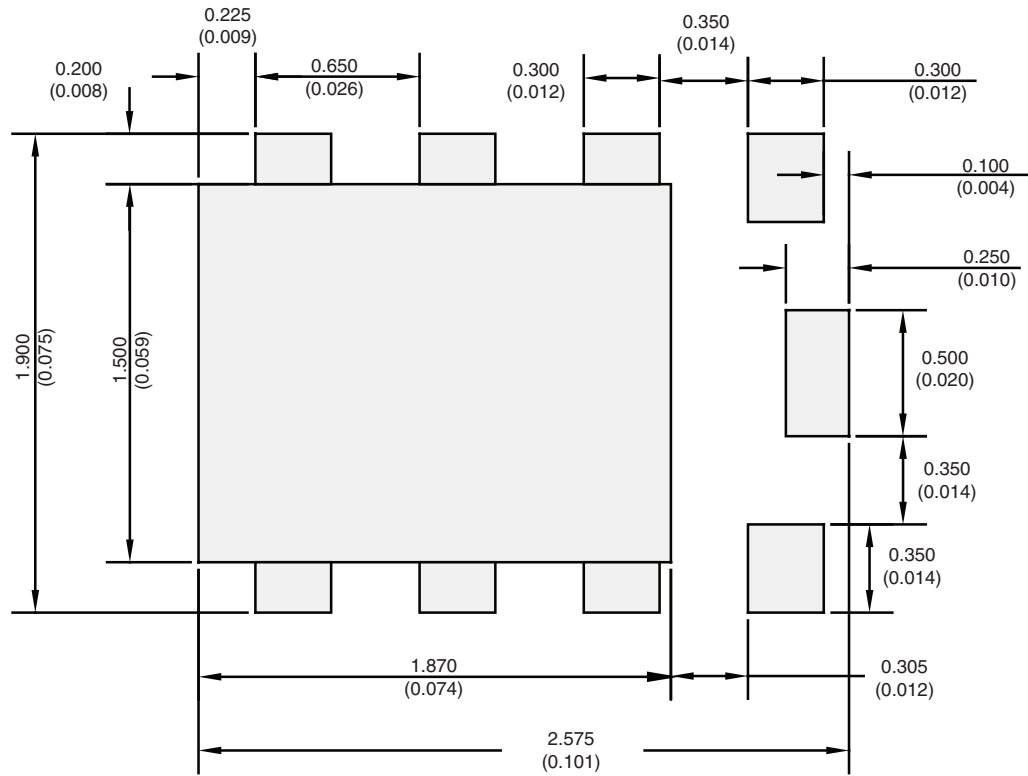
