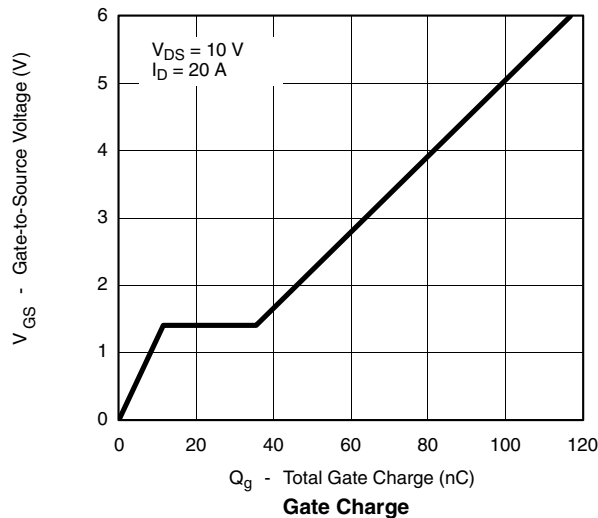
## TYPICAL CHARACTERISTICS 25 °C, unless otherwise noted



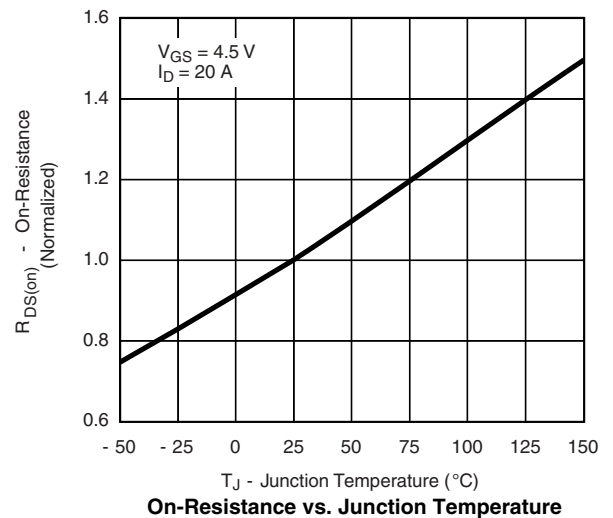
On-Resistance vs. Drain Current



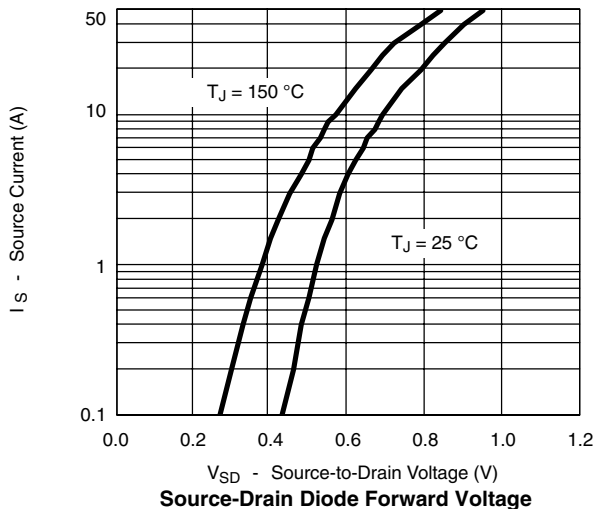
Capacitance



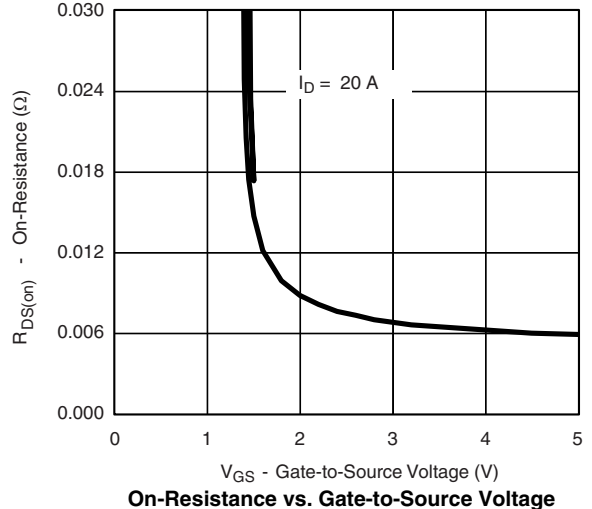
Gate Charge



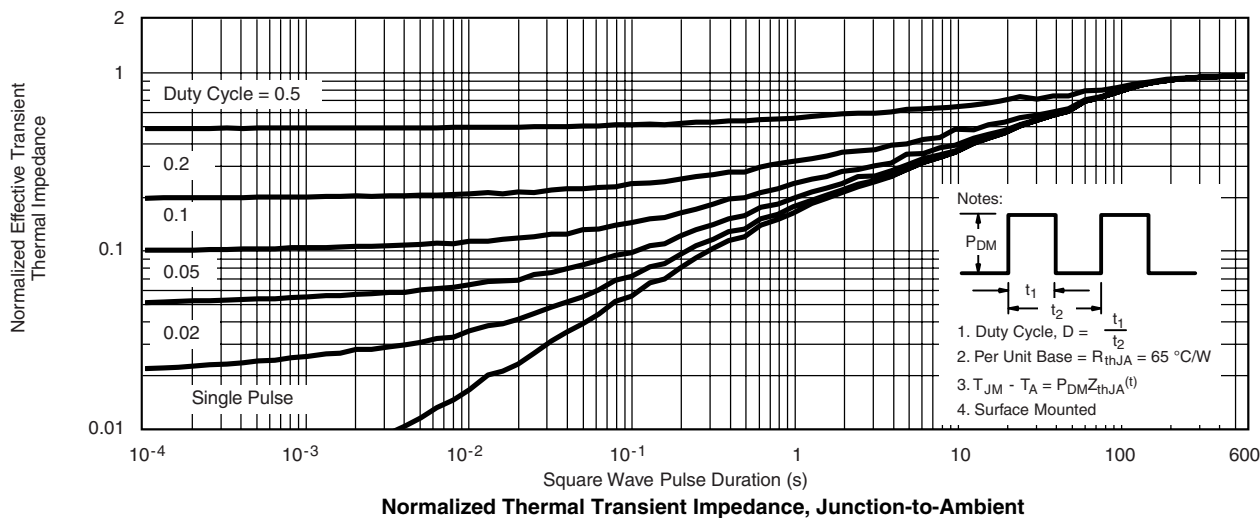
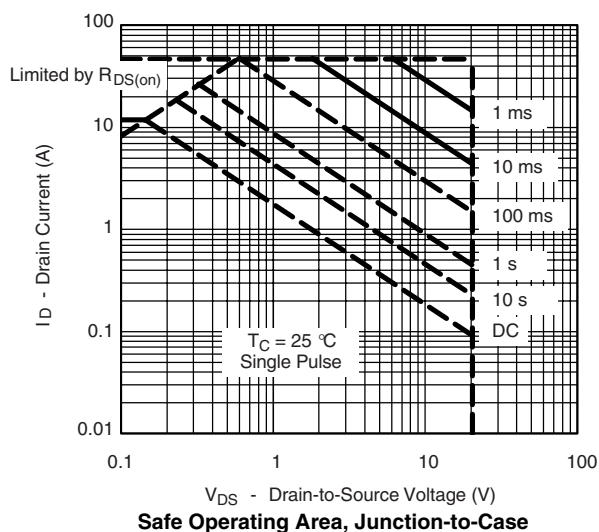
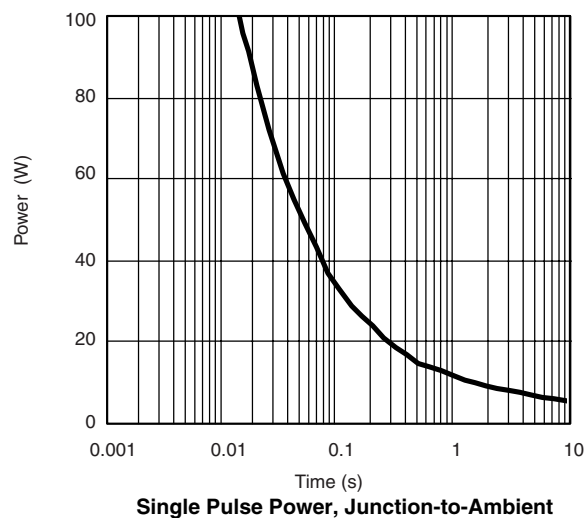
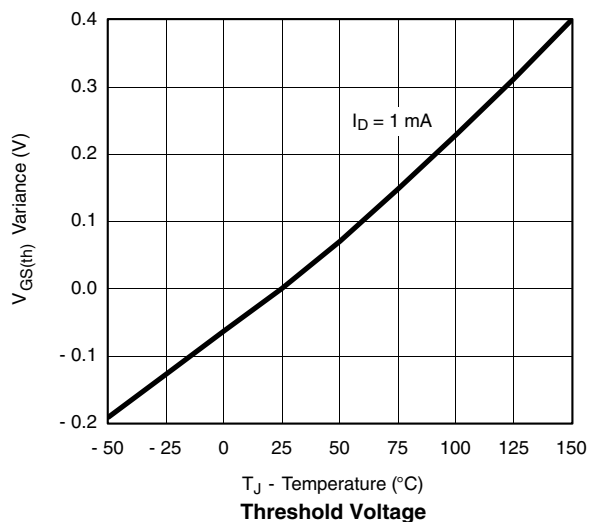
On-Resistance vs. Junction Temperature



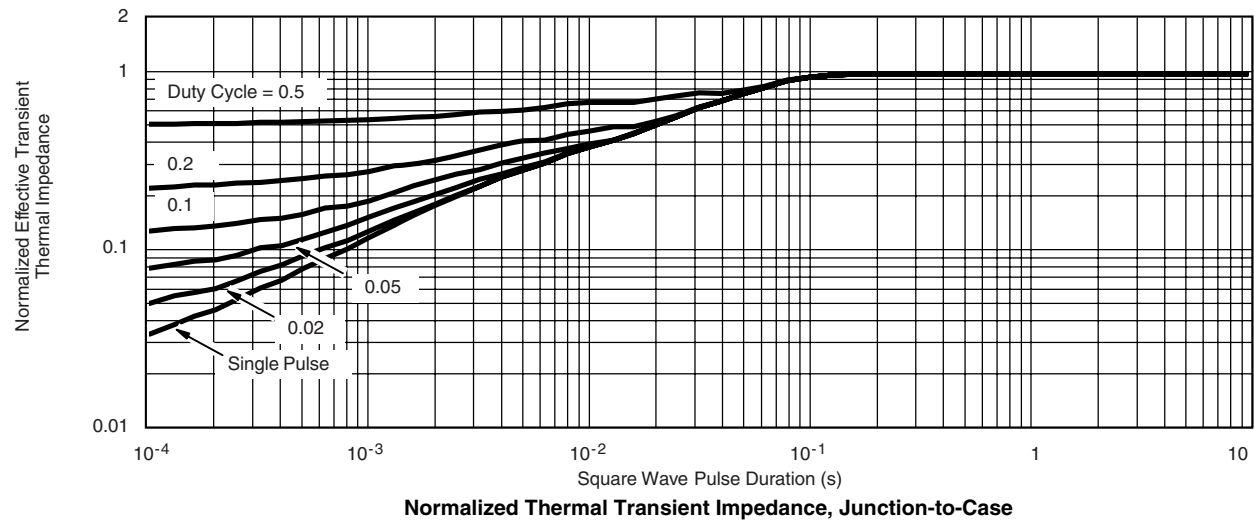
Source-Drain Diode Forward Voltage
