



Figure 1. Safe operating area for TO-220 / D²PAK




Figure 2. Thermal impedance for TO-220 / D²PAK




Figure 3. Safe operating area for TO-247




Figure 4. Thermal impedance for TO-247




Figure 5. Output characteristics




Figure 6. Transfer characteristics




Figure 7. Normalized B_{VDSS} vs temperature Figure 8. Static drain-source on resistance




Figure 9. Gate charge vs gate-source voltage Figure 10. Capacitance variations




Figure 11. Normalized gate threshold voltage vs temperature Figure 12. Normalized on resistance vs temperature




Figure 13. Source-drain diode forward characteristics





Figure 14. Avalanche energy vs starting T_j

Figure 15. Switching times test circuit for resistive load




Figure 16. Gate charge test circuit




Figure 17. Test circuit for inductive load switching and diode recovery times




Figure 18. Unclamped inductive load test circuit




Figure 19. Unclamped inductive waveform





Figure 20. Switching time waveform




