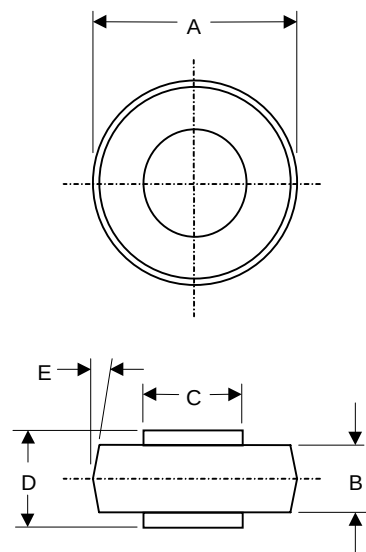

Typical Forward Characteristics

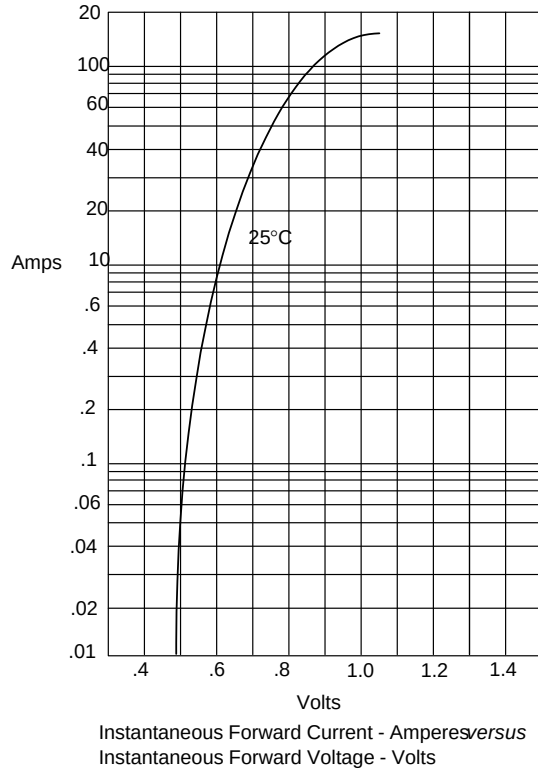

Forward Derating Curve

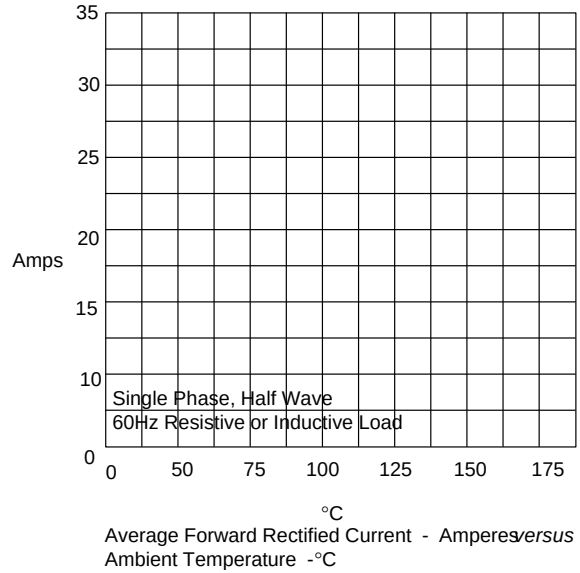

Peak Forward Surge Current

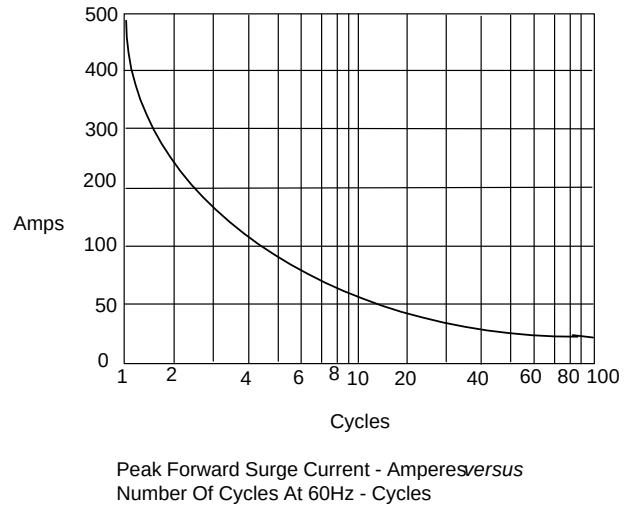
