


**Figure 1. Typical Forward Voltage Drop vs. Forward Current**




**Figure 2. Typical Reverse Current vs. Reverse Voltage**




**Figure 3. Typical Junction Capacitance**

**Figure 5. Typical Stored Charge vs. Forward Current**




**Figure 6. Forward Current Derating Curve**
